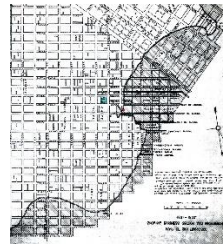


Join me, Nancy Johnsen, for a 3-mile walking tour of
